The parade will stage in the KCCA parking lot at 9:30am. The parade will leave the parking lot at 10:30am. HNSC will provide donuts, coffee, juice, etc. during the staging hour. The police and fire department will lead the parade, followed by the Grand Marshal, walkers, bikers, golf carts and classic cars.

The route will be fined tuned, but it will follow last year's route to Fischer Road and then go into the Edgewater community. The exact route in Edgewater is yet to be determined, but the walkers and bikers will go to King City Community Park. At a point still to be determined, the golf carts and cars will go back into the KCCA community with a police escort, and follow King George to the clubhouse.

There will be children's activities, vendor stalls, music, food carts at the King City Community Park from 11:30 – 2:30. A shuttle bus/van will run from 9 am to 3 pm between various locations in KCCA and King City Community Park.

KCCA HNSC will host a hot dog feed like last year for residents. Prizes will be awarded to the carts and cars.

The parade will not go past Senior Village this year, but there will be an area cordoned off at the corner of Queen Elizabeth and Royalty Parkway for their residents. They will judge the cars and carts as they have done in the past.

The city will provide insurance and police escorts for the parade.
